Hillsboro Trojan Family Memorial Scholarship

The Hillsboro Trojan Family Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2020 by the Hillsboro Community Foundation. Scholarships from this fund will be awarded based on a combined criterion of financial need, potential success in college, as well as the student’s involvement in school and community activities.

Donations to fund the endowment of the scholarship are currently being accepted from alumni, friends and other supporters of the Hillsboro USD 410 school district including the community of Durham (Durham Hornets), and Lehigh (Lehigh Eagles). Gifts can be made either in honor or in memory of a classmate, faculty, or staff member.

Demarius Lives Scholarship

The Demarius Lives Scholarship Fund was established to provide financial assistance to graduates of Hillsboro High School who are furthering their careers through higher educational or vocational pursuits. Current graduating seniors are eligible. Scholarship is based primarily on character.

Preference will be given to applicants pursuing higher education in the areas of Communications or Journalism but not in exclusion of declaring other majors or trades. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or greater. Qualified individuals are those who plan to attend a public or private college/university or accredited vocational, technical or trade school.
